Wayne County Addressing Environmental Site

WAYNE COUNTY, MI — October 20, 2006 Wayne County and Huron Township officials have coordinated efforts to address environmental concerns at a concrete stockpile on the County's Pinnacle property.

The County plans to design and build an engineered detention pond system to manage stormwater runoff at the site. The pond will remain in place until the concrete is removed and recycled as part of the Pinnacle project.

"My Economic Development team, led by Dr. Mulu Birru, has worked with Huron Township and listened to their concerns. We inherited this problem, and we are committed to fixing it the best we can. We've crafted a plan, and we're carrying it out." said County Executive Robert A. Ficano.
