## **Wayne County's Mortgage Foreclosure Prevention Program empowers Redford residents to save their homes**

**Wayne County** – The Wayne County Mortgage Foreclosure Prevention Program (MFPP) will provide Redford residents with information about the resources available to them to avoid or survive mortgage foreclosure. The presentation, titled *Foreclosure Prevention and Protecting Your Home Investment*, will be held at no cost at the Redford Township Hall on October 21 at 6 p.m., presented by Township Supervisor Tracey Schulz Kobylarz and Commissioner Diane L. Webb. Wayne County Executive Robert Ficano will open the discussion about the program.

“We developed the MFPP because we are dedicated to helping our residents, one-by-one, case-by-case, protect their greatest investment: their homes,” said Executive Ficano. “We are thankful to Supervisor Kobylarz and Commissioner Webb for the opportunity to meet with Redford residents, present them with their options and answer their questions.”

MFPP's certified counselors, joined by United Way 2-1-1, will share with residents information on how to take control of their financial destinies and protect their home, utilities and health. Residents will learn how to participate in the Mortgage Foreclosure Prevention Program and about the budget management, wellness and utility assistance programs offered by United Way 2-1-1. The seminar is closed by a question and answer session.

Said Supervisor Kobylarz, “It is important to us to bring the MFPP and United Way 2-1-1 to Redford because both programs are allies homeowners can depend on to help them navigate the mortgage foreclosure process and work with lenders. The goal is achieving the best possible resolution for our homeowners.”

“The Mortgage Foreclosure Prevention Program and United Way 2-1-1 programs have the resources that enable them to work quickly, which contributes to the programs' high success rate in helping homeowners,” said Commissioner Webb.

The MFPP offers an expansive network of certified counselors whose solid relationships with lenders allow them to provide secure, confidential and competent assistance to homeowners

facing foreclosure. The program has helped nearly 2,000 residents across Wayne County avoid or survive mortgage foreclosure.
