Deposit must be mailed to Sheriff's Training Unit one (1) week before day of class, accompanied by registration form found on Sheriff's website. Both advance deposit and course fee must be made by **money order** payable to Wayne County Sheriff's Office. Deposit is non-refundable.

Required Equipment:

- Safety Eyeglasses
- Shooter's Earmuffs (Not Ear Plugs)
- Pen or Pencil
- Baseball Cap
- Loose comfortable clothing appropriate for the range
(No Shorts, Open Toe Shoes, Dresses, or Tank Tops)

However, guns and ammunition are provided.

For safety reasons, long fingernails are discouraged.
