The following items are prohibited in all Third Circuit Court Buildings which include court rooms in : Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, 2 Woodward Avenue, Detroit; Friend of the Court Office, Penobscot Building, 645 Griswold, Detroit; Family Division – Juvenile Complex, 1025 East Forest, Detroit, and Frank Murphy Hall of Justice, 1441 St. Antoine, Detroit.
