

Commissioner Varga sponsored or co-sponsored the following ordinances to help improve the quality of life in Wayne County:

2000

Public Nuisance Ordinance

An ordinance that declares racing a vehicle on a public street without a permit to be a public nuisance and to provide for forfeiture or impoundment of a vehicle

Nuisance and Blighted Properties Ordinance

An ordinance to address the nuisance created and existing because of abandoned and blighted properties and vacant lots in Wayne County and to authorize the CEO's office to abate such nuisance properties by acquiring, conveying, demolishing and/or improving such properties

2002

Homeland Security Ordinance

An ordinance to establish a comprehensive homeland security program, to establish departmental powers and duties, and to authorize departmental grant applications to enhance Homeland Security readiness

Drug Trafficking Nuisance Abatement Ordinance

An ordinance to establish a program to institute nuisance abatement/forfeiture of residential properties that are repeatedly used for illegal drug trafficking activities and to transfer title to community organizations for rehabilitation and sale to an owner

2004

One-Stop Business Assistance Shop Ordinance

An ordinance to establish Wayne County's One Stop Business Assistance Shop

Marine Safety Code Ordinance

An ordinance to adopt a marine safety code for the operation of watercraft on waters within Wayne County

Living Wage Ordinance

An ordinance requiring employers who contract with Wayne County or who receive basic living needs.

2005

Wayne County Halal and Kosher Anti-Fraud and Truth-in-Labeling Ordinance

An ordinance to establish consumer fraud protection for citizens who purchase "halal" or kosher foods; to regulate conduct of any "halal" and kosher food provider and to make it a misdemeanor to fraudulently advertise or represent that a product is "halal" or kosher.

Immunization Ordinance

An ordinance to permit the Wayne County health department to waive fees and charges for immunizations in economic hardship cases

2006**Nuisance Noise Ordinance**

An ordinance to preserve the public peace from the noise and disturbance of amplified music and other sounds heard after ten o'clock on weekdays and after midnight on weekends, establish penalties for violation and to establish procedures for enforcement

Curfew Ordinance

An ordinance to establish curfew hours for juveniles, create offenses and penalties for violation and to establish procedures for enforcement

Graffiti Control Ordinance

An ordinance to establish a graffiti control and elimination program, which prohibits the defacement of property, sale of aerosol paint to minors, and requires sellers of aerosol paint to take strong measures to preclude theft

Drug Paraphernalia Ordinance

An ordinance to prohibit the sale of drug paraphernalia and to provide penalties for violation

2007**Nuisance Abatement Ordinance**

An ordinance authorizing the County CEO's office, or its departments or agents to acquire, convey, sell, demolish or improve properties identified as nuisances in order to create and maintain safe, stable, revitalized communities in Wayne County.
