

Important Notice!

Effective October 1, 2003 the fees for obtaining a Wayne County Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Permit will increase. The attached fee schedule was approved by a vote of the Wayne County Commission on September 18, 2003. **All new SESC permit applications and permit renewals received on or after October 1, 2003 must reflect these new fees.**

Please note that the duration of the Single Family Residence permit has been extended from one year to two years so that, in most cases, permit renewal will not be necessary.

Obviously, fee increases such as this directly impact your construction costs. However, the Wayne County soil erosion control program is entirely funded through the collection of plan review & inspection fees and our fees have not increased since 1989. This increase was necessary in order for us to continue to provide the level of customer service that you have come to expect.

- * Construction permits are for 30 months from date issued.
- * Single Family Residence permits are for 24 months from date issued.
- * Annual permits are for 12 months from date of issue.
