

**Public Notice of Availability and Opportunity to Comment
Proposed Substantial Amendment
To the Wayne County 2008 Annual Action Plan
For the Community Development Block Grant – Recovery Act Program (CDBG-R)**

The federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) was signed into law on February 17, 2009. As part of the Recovery Act, funds are available under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG-R), administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Wayne County is eligible to apply for \$1,508,234 in CDBG-R funds. These funds may be used to for critical employment and economic development needs, and to help cover grant administrative costs.

The CDBG-R application requires a substantial amendment to the 2008 Wayne County Annual Action Plan (2008 Action Plan). This proposed substantial amendment indicates how the County plans to distribute and administer the HPRP funds and provides a preliminary estimated budget summary.
