



Important Notice from the CHARTER COUNTY OF WAYNE Regarding WOMEN'S HEALTH AND CANCER RIGHTS ACT

The Federal Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 requires that benefits must be provided for:

- Reconstruction of a surgically removed breast;
- Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance; and
- Prostheses and treatment for physical complications from all stages of mastectomy, including lymph edemas

These benefits are subject to applicable terms and conditions under your health plan, including copayments, deductible and coinsurance provisions. They are also subject to medical insurance limitations and exclusions.

Important Notice from the CHARTER COUNTY OF WAYNE Regarding NEWBORNS AND MOTHERS HEALTH PROTECTION ACT

Group health plans and health insurance issuers offering group health insurance coverage may not, under federal law, restrict benefits for any hospital length of stay in connection with childbirth for the mother or newborn child for less than 48 hours following normal vaginal delivery, or less than 96 hours following a cesarean section, or require that a provider obtain authorization from the plan or insurance issuer for prescribing a length of stay not in excess of the above periods.
